2017 Heritage Awards Call for Nominations

Do you know someone who has made significant contributions to conserve and celebrate Yukon's heritage?

The Yukon Historical & Museums Association is seeking nominations for the 2017 Heritage Awards. The deadline for submissions is midnight on January 15, 2018. Nominations are accepted in the following categories:

Annual Heritage Award: Awarded to an individual, organization, First Nation or business for an outstanding contribution to Yukon heritage.

History Maker Award: Awarded to an individual, organization, First Nation or business for outstanding contributions to Yukon heritage over a period of many years.

Helen Couch Volunteer of the Year Award: Awarded to an individual for an outstanding volunteer contribution to Yukon heritage.

Heritage Conservation Project of the Year Award: Awarded by the Yukon Historic Sites Unit to the individual, community group, First Nation or business whose work to preserve, restore or rehabilitate a historic property best reflects the principles and practise outlined in the *Standards and Guidelines for the Conservation of Historic Places in Canada*.

Innovation, Education and Community Engagement Award: Awarded to an individual, organization, First Nation or business who demonstrates leadership, innovative approaches or outstanding contributions in encouraging ongoing education and community engagement with the Yukon's heritage.
